American - -South African Cooperation

US investments in South Africa include Chase Manhattan Bank, The Firstj National City Bⁿk of New York, Ford, GMC, Standard Oil, Pepsi Cola, Transvaal Engelhardt, Tanganyika Concessions, Anglo-American Corp. The U.S. and South Africa jointly brought down democratically elected government of Patrice Lumumba in the Congo and later South African mercenaries were airlifted in CIA planes to crush the Stanleyville Revolutionary Government.

The U.S. has helped South Africa build a nuclear reactor making that country the first potential nuclear power on the African continent. The U.S. government together with its NATO allies and South Africa are the chief suppliers of weapons to the Portuguese Facists in their war to retain control over Mozambique and Angola.

The U.S. government has been one of the chief impediments in blocking UN sanctions against trade with South Africa.
